

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility

- Suppliers must provide proof of legal registration, a valid tax compliance certificate, and business permits.
- Suppliers must not be debarred or suspended from participating in public procurement.

2. Submission Requirements

- Suppliers must complete the registration process by submitting all required documents accurately and within specified deadlines.
- Suppliers must provide valid bid security where required.

3. Technical and Financial Capacity

- Suppliers must demonstrate adequate technical, financial, and operational capacity to perform contracts.
- Suppliers must provide references for past performance in similar contracts where applicable.

4. Ethical Conduct

- Suppliers must adhere to ethical procurement standards, including non-involvement in corrupt or collusive practices.
- Suppliers must declare any conflicts of interest.

5. Preference and Reservations

• Suppliers from youth, women, and persons with disabilities (PWDs) categories are eligible for preferential treatment as per government policy.

6. Compliance with Laws

 Suppliers must comply with all relevant laws and regulations, including anti-corruption and competition laws.

7. Debarment and Termination

• Suppliers may be debarred from the portal if they fail to meet contractual obligations or engage in unethical practices.

8. Complaints and Dispute Resolution

• Suppliers can seek redress through the Public Procurement Administrative Review Board (PPARB) for disputes related to the registration or procurement process.
